Women come from near and far to work with Herstory's founder and artistic director Erika Duncan in an intensive format, which is designed to simultaneously launch new projects and help those with projects underway to delve into larger writing issues specific to their ventures.

Enjoy the warmth and diversity of the Herstory family in this unique workshop where writing, community building and healing are combined.

The day-long format allows new participants to develop their ideas in the morning, to curl up in a cozy indoor spot or walk a block to the beach to begin writing during the lunch break, and to receive immediate feedback in the afternoon.

And for those with writing projects underway, the morning session becomes a time to read aloud and to move the work forward in response to group input.
